

The Beach Club at Charleston Harbor Resort & Marina



For a town that revolves around the waterfront lifestyle, hotels on the water are all but unheard of in Charleston; which is part of what makes The Beach Club so special. Yards from the Cooper River and a stones-throw from the USS Yorktown, this LEED-certified hotel (the only one in town) offers lots of seafaring amenities like boat excursions, an hourly water taxi to downtown, and opportunities to take sailing lessons from the pros who work with the acclaimed College of Charleston sailing team.

For those who prefer their feet firmly on dry land, almost every room offers a waterside view, as well as outdoor lounges, fire pits, and cabanas to take in the sight of the Ravenel Bridge with a glass of poolside Frosé.
